Southwest Ohio Family Farm Safety Lawn Mower & Small Engine Safety Topics

- 1. Wear ear and eye protection and safe shoes when mowing.
- 2. Let an engine cool before refueling.
- 3. Wear heavy gloves and use wood blocks to avoid rotation when changing blades.
- 4. Use a box end wrench or socket set versus adjustable wrenches or pliers to remove blade bolt or nut.
- 5. Do not remove guards.
- 6. Remove sparkplug wire when changing blades.
- 7. NEVER ride children in arms or on deck or hood.
- 8. Keep yard free of baling twine, limbs, rocks and wire.
- 9. Don't mow when lawn is wet.
- 10. Remove low hanging branches.
- 11. Remove rings and watches when working on mower.
- 12. Avoid ditches, holes and muddy areas.
- 13. Don't pull out a stuck mower with a chain or strap without covering it with a heavy coat or tarp.
- 14. Don't let young children mow.
- 15. Avoid carrying full fuel cans in vehicle interior.
- 16. Don't fill gas cans in vehicle.
- 17. Safely support mower if changing blade(s) or tire.
- 18. Use a gage when inflating tires to avoid over inflation and an explosion.
- 19. Replace damaged bolts and nuts and missing lock washers.
- 20. Avoid mowing on steep slopes.
- 21. Don't blow grass on roads and streets.
- 22. Keep all safety devices in working order.
- 23. Don't mow with people or pets present.
